DATIM v1.21.e allows for SIMS 3.0 data import and adds clarifying text to the HTS_TST – KP and KP_PREV disaggregates

SIMS:

1. SIMS 3.0 data elements are now available

The data elements for SIMS 3.0 have been added to production and are now available for data import.

2. Ability to import SIMS above site data at varying levels

SIMS above site assessments can now be submitted at any levels between the OU level and one level above the facility level.
